Unfortunately, she couldn't go any further and gave her quest to be continued by McKay. From that moment on, he began his own quest, and it is in these paintings in which it is achieved.


The interesting aspect about McKay's quest is that it is also given to the viewer. This experience requests patience; because the more the viewer contemplates his paintings, the more they discover new colors and shadows. McKay's work is not just a standing experience, but also a moving and interactive moment. One of the first elements seen in his paintings are the lines in vertical or horizontal display; just looking forward you perceive his difficult quest of achieving nothingness.
